

The College of Arts & Sciences has a dual advising system in conjunction with departmental faculty advisors. If a student wants to change their major to a department in CAS, they would meet with their faculty advisor to declare their major and begin the process for obtaining an official degree audit.

A few exceptions are as follows:

- Prospective **RTVF and Converged Broadcast Media** majors must complete a Pre Major application and submit it to the Media Arts dept. They must be accepted into the program and have at least a 2.75 UNT GPA in order to enroll in major courses.
- Prospective **Psychology** majors have an option to meet with the faculty advisor, graduate student assistant, or the CAS satellite advisor in Terrill hall
- Prospective **International Studies** majors must meet with a designated CAS advisor for the time being, KAS McConnell, until the INST advisor is fully trained
- Prospective **Biology, Biochemistry, Ecology, Medical Laboratory Science** majors are recommended to meet with a CAS advisor first before their faculty advisor
- Prospective **Integrative Studies** majors must attend a 50 minute information session held at least weekly. They can contact the CAS Advising office to sign up for a session.
